1. Time schedule

1.1 Dates of racing

| Day | Date | The planned time of the warning signal for the first race each day is |
|----------|------------|---|
| Friday | 2019-08-16 | 17:00 (2 races planned) |
| Saturday | 2019-08-17 | 10:00 (4 races planned) |
| Sunday | 2019-08-18 | 10:00 (2 races planned) |

On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 13:30

- 1.2 To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.
- 1.3 8 races are scheduled during the regatta
- 1.4 The race committee will try to set the course so that a race will take approximately 60 minutes to sail.
- 1.5 Notice to competitors is published on the notice board latest Friday 1600, latest 0830 Saturday and Sunday.

2. Location of the race office and of the flagpole

- 2.1 The regatta office is located in FBK Clubhouse
- 2.2 Signals made ashore will be displayed at FBK Clubhouse

3. Marks

- 3.1 The rounding marks are yellow cylinders.

 The start mark is a yellow buoy with yellow flag together with the starting vessel.

 The finish mark is a yellow buoy with yellow flag together with the start vessel.
- 3.2 When changing the course, the original mark and the starting vessel will be moved. This changes AppSF 10.1

4. Race format

4.1 Class/start Flag


5. Racing area

5.1 The location of the racing area will be less than 1NM outside the harbour.

6. The course

- 6.1 Upwind downwind course to be sailed two laps. Start 1 1a 4s/4b 1 1a finish.
- 6.2 If flag **T** is displayed before or together with the warning signal the course shall be sailed three laps. Start -1 1a 4s/4b 1 1a 4s/4b 1 1a finish.
- 6.3 The race committee will try to set the course so that it will take approximately 60 minutes to sail. Distance 4b-4s and upwind 1-1a is approximately 8 boat lengths





7. Time limits

7.1 Race Time Limit

Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish is 120 minutes.

7.2 Finishing Window

Finishing window is 30 minutes.

7.3 Mark 1 Time Limit

Time limit for the first boat to pass Mark 1 is 30 minutes.

8. Signals

8.1 All signals will be using a horn.

9. Protests and penalty systems

- 9.1 RRS 44.1 will be changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe is required for a boat that may have broken a rule in RRS part2.
- 9.2 Protests shall be delivered to the race office within the protest time limit. The protest time limit is 30 minutes and begins when the boats have had reasonable time to return to the harbour after the last race of the day. The end of the protest time will be posted on the official notice board.
